Pre-Participating Sports Medication Information:

For students who will need to have an Epi Pen or an Inhaler while participating in sports, please read the following:

Any medication which the student will be self-administering will need to have an **Authorization for the Administration of Medicines by School Personnel form (available on SWHS website under forms link – Health Forms)** filled out by the doctor and the parent indicating that the student is capable of self-administrating his/her medication. It must be handed in with this form, and on file in the Health Office prior to the start of participating in sports.

If your son/daughter will NOT be able to self-administer an Epi Pen or an Inhaler, the parent will need to give the medication directly to the coach. Please note that an Epi-Pen or an Inhaler brought into the Health Office will NOT be given to the coach. A separate Epi Pen and/or Inhaler needs to be given to the coach. Coaches will be able to administer only Inhalers and EpiPens if the student is not capable of self-administrating these medications. The parent must bring in the medication labeled from the pharmacy, along with the **Authorization for the Administration of Medicines by School Personnel form (available on SWHS website under forms link – Health Forms)** filled out and signed by both the doctor and the parent. It must be handed in with this form and on file in the Health Office prior to the start of participating in sports.
