Course Overview: In this course, students will grow in their understanding of, and ability to create in 2-dimensions, ie drawing, painting, collage, etc. The design studio will develop a student’s understanding of the various organizational possibilities available in creating within the two-dimensional surface using The Elements and Principles of Art and Design.
