**Course Overview:**  
 In this studio course, students learn about the essential elements of painting through color theory and its applications. Students will become acquainted with a broad range of painting techniques as well as the use and care of the painting tools and materials. Tempera, watercolor, and acrylics will be used. Individual and weekly group critiques. Preliminary plans and sketches are part of the creative process and are required.

- *apply and communicate knowledge and skills* as they create original works of art for all of their assignments in the three different mediums: tempera, watercolor and acrylic.

- *gather, assess and analyze to solve problems* as they create and reflect upon their work
- *contribute to the studio community and demonstrate respect for self and others* whether in discussion or by not harming others' artwork.

**Materials and Resources to Support Student Learning:**  
 A sketchbook is required. Students should come to class ready to work. When necessary the students should have the specific materials that pertain to certain projects i.e. Research materials and painting tools...
