Course Overview:

In the first quarter, this course will guide art students in the preparation of their portfolio for art school/ art major applications, college interviews, portfolio reviews and competitions. The student will prepare a written contract with the instructor of their area which outlines the student's area of focus and project goals for the portfolio. Additional studio work in their focus area is required and must be arranged before admission to the class. Portfolio assignments are aligned with the admission portfolio requirements of the schools that the students are applying to. Topics covered in the studio will include imagery development, matting, digital documentation, writing, and overall presentation techniques.

In the second quarter, senior art students will continue to work on individualized imagery development, artist statements, and documentation of the artwork. In the second semester, junior art students will review their artwork to date, and prepare a written contract with the instructor of their area which outlines the student's strengths and art project goals for the semester following the Advanced Portfolio List. Individual and weekly group critiques. A folder will include the artist statement, digital inventory, rubrics, self evaluations and reflections. Preliminary plans and sketches are part of the creative process and are required.

Students will create and maintain a digital portfolio of their work.

Students will create original works of art for all of their assignments.

Students will compile the works of previous art classes for their portfolio.

Students will create designs for artwork that will be made during the semester.
